



Chapter Leadership

Requirements: Chapter Leaders guide their designated chapter and oversee all activities. Chapter Leaders must be IAUG voting members in good standing and actively engaged in the chapter to which they belong. There must be at least one Chapter Leader to act as liaison with IAUG Headquarters for each affiliated chapter.

Time Commitment: 1 to 2 hours per month

Responsibilities:

- Chapter leader shall assist in carrying out the general objectives of IAUG to educate and inform members in areas of communications technology, with emphasis on the Avaya product lines
- Maintain an ongoing channel of communications between Avaya and the members
- Provide a network of individuals with common concerns
- Work with sponsors to generate educational content for meeting agendas
- Initiate communication process for upcoming meetings with support from IAUG
- Facilitate local meeting logistics and efforts
- Affiliate chapter liaisons are requested to participate on all IAUG Chapter leadership calls and meetings or send a representative
